Hope for Ghana is a non-profit public charity dedicated to transforming lives and creating opportunities in rural Ghana through education, access to clean water, vocational training, and healthcare. By fostering hope, empowerment, and sustainability, we strive to build resilient communities and brighter futures for generations to come



2025 Program Accomplishments

Education

- Continued construction of Hope for Ghana’s fifth school, Benjamin’s School of Hope, including 7 classrooms, library, clean water, bathrooms and sanitation
- Began construction of Hope for Ghana’s 13th library and computer lab, The Sean Kwaku Ahia Library, expanding educational resources for students



Clean Water

- Launched our largest water project to date: the expansion of a water dam in Jarigu to provide year-round clean water to over 10,000 people. Work will continue into 2026 creating a full filtration and treatment system
- Drilled and installed 25 boreholes across rural villages throughout Ghana, providing clean water to communities in need



Vocational Training

- 30 apprenticeships sponsored for young men and women
- Training focuses on practical, marketable skills that support employment and long-term economic stability

Healthcare

- Mobile Medical Outreach program, operating with three medical vehicles, conducted nearly 100 outreach events in remote and vulnerable communities, delivering health screenings, counseling, vaccinations, medications, and medical treatment
- Served 20,000 individuals in communities with little to no access to healthcare
