Information We Collect

When individuals make a donation or interact with our organization, we may collect personal information such as name, address, email address, and donation details.

How Information Is Used

This information is used to:

- Process donations
- Provide receipts and acknowledgments
- Communicate updates about Hope for Ghana's programs and impact

Sharing of Information

Hope for Ghana does not sell, trade, or share donor personal information with third parties.

Donor Preferences

Donors may request to opt out of communications from Hope for Ghana at any time. Donors may also request to review or update their personal information by contacting the organization directly.

Security

Hope for Ghana takes reasonable and appropriate steps to protect donor information. Access to donor data is limited to authorized individuals who require the information to perform their responsibilities. Donor information is stored in password-protected systems, and secure technologies such as SSL (Secure Socket Layer) encryption are used when donations are processed through our website.
